Unfortunately, this year due to COVID, we are unable to continue with this tradition. Instead we are having a virtual carol service where musicians and readers have been filmed performing the Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols and this will be shown to all classes after lunch on the last day of term.

The final lesson will be in form groups where fun activities for the end the term have been arranged.

Friday 17th December will also be a non-uniform day in aid of Oscar's Paediatric Brain Tumour Charity, Hull Refugees and Children in Need. Students and staff are encouraged to wear a Christmas jumper to celebrate the end of term. The cost of wearing non-uniform is £1. We respectfully request that items worn are suitable for a day at school and normal hair, makeup and jewellery rules apply.
